Mule Deer in the 200 class are possible. Quail are making a comeback and are plentiful, while previewing the Ranch many coveys of Blues and Bobs were seen along with dove.

Water:

Water on the Ranch is plentiful, with tanks that hold well. During the drought most of these were cleaned and deepened and are now full. Community water is available and water is shallow and sweet perfect for a solar well.
